KEY BIBLE PASSAGE: Matthew 6:19-24

DISCUSSION:

- (Icebreaker) If you had an unlimited amount of money to be generous with, what would you do with it?
- Read Matthew 6:19-24
- What are some examples of earthly treasures? (v19)
- What are some examples of heavenly treasures? (v20) (See: John 14:2, Heb 11:13-16, Col 3:1-4, Rev 3:21)
- (Self-Reflection) What earthly treasures might take your eyes off of heavenly treasures?
- Share a story where your heart wasn't in it, but you knew it was a good thing to do anyway. Why does "your heart" follow "your treasure"? (v21)
- The "eye" refers to one's mind How does someone develop a kingdom mindset? (v22-23)
- If you were daily to focus on heavenly treasures, how might this bring joy, thankfulness, and even motivation to life? (v24)
- Read 1 Chronicles 29:14-16
 - What insight does this passage give us about "our" finances?
 - How does this change our posture toward giving generously?

• One gives freely, yet grows all the richer; another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want.

Proverbs 11:25-26 ESV

"Whoever brings blessing will be enriched, and one who waters will himself be watered. The people curse him who holds back grain, but a blessing is on the head of him who sells it."

II Corinthians 9:6 ESV
