Read the CF Statement of Belief

Theological Truths

The Church Local - Church Universal

I Corinthians 1:2 - To the church of God that is in Corinth – along with those in every place

I Thessalonians 1:1 - To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ

Romans 16:3,4,5 - Prisca and Aguila - greet the church in their house.

We must be part of the Church universal and local.

I Peter 2:5;9 - you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

Don't say I love Jesus but not the church!

John 17:21-23 - I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me.

Hebrews 10:24-25 - And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
