Read Matthew 20:17-28 (ESV)

Jesus Foretells His Death (Matthew 20: 17-19)

- Describe some of the feelings associated with this passage.
- Have you ever been mocked? What was that like?
- How do you think Jesus hoped His disciples would respond?

A Mother's Request (Matthew 20:20-28)

- Why did the mother ask this for her sons?
- In verse 20, how does the word "Then", which refers back to vs 17-19, bring context to this narrative?
- Why did Jesus respond by talking about drinking the cup? What is He talking about?
- Why do you think that we as humans often get the definition of greatness backwards & mixed up?
- In verse 24, why were the other Disciples indignant?
- In verse 23, what are the implications that Jesus didn't deny that there will be people sitting on His right and on His left?

Practical Application

- How does a posture of entitlement misguide a person's life?
- How does having a correct perspective on your value change your posture?
- How do you feel when you are treated like a slave or someone's servant?
- What are some ways that you may need to be more of a slave or a servant at home or at work?
- How would our church look differently if it was filled with Christians who had a servant's heart & attitude?
